

magine sitting in a comfortable chair at sunset, sipping fine wine and marveling at the vineyard's beauty. Well, that could be one of the many delights you experience if you come to Entegra Owners' Summerfest II, planned and hosted by us, Tom and Regina Searle.

We have scheduled the second-annual Summerfest to be held June 9-13, 2014 at Wine Country RV Resort in beautiful Paso Robles, Calif. The Summerfest fee of \$406 per coach (for two people) includes four nights at Wine Country RV Resort, a Welcome Party with wood-fired gourmet pizza, tri-dip barbecue, sides and dessert, plus three hot breakfasts and one continental breakfast.

Paso Robles is located approximately halfway between the cities of Los Angeles and San Francisco. Paso Robles is known for its hot springs, abundant wineries, production of olive oil and almond orchards. For a time, this city was known as the "Almond City," because the local almond growers created the largest concentration of almond orchards in the world.

More than 25 different varietals of grapes are grown within this wine country with over 200 vineyards and 26,000 vineyard acres. The distinct micro-climates and diverse soils make grape-growing conditions ideal for producing more than 40 wine varietals, including Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Syrah, Viognier, Roussanne and Zinfandel.

With its Mediterranean climate, the Central Coast has long been an agricultural region. Not only is it perfect for growing grapes but olives as well. The region's hot dry summers and mild wet winters, combined with rocky soil, make it similar to Tuscany, which may explain why almost all of the region's olive oil producers grow some Tuscan oil varietals. Production of olive oil in the Paso Robles area is more artisan than commercial. Handpicking is the norm, which we recently witnessed first hand.





DID YOU KNOW?

By Joyce Skinner

The batteries in your Entegra Coach are designed to operate more efficiently if the voltage stays above 11.5 volts. Any time it falls below that, some of the battery life is depleted. Your inverter/charger will keep this above the 11.5 volts without overcharging the batteries.

If you have wet cell batteries, be sure to keep the water at the proper level and do not overfill them. Some of the acid will otherwise overflow out of the batteries, also shortening the life of the batteries. If your unit is equipped with AGM batteries, you don't need to add water.

It is also advisable to adjust the setting to the "automatic generator start," no lower than 11.5. Click here for directions on how to adjust this feature, found on pages 18-20 of this digital PDF. A final note, the "start voltage" should not be below 11.5 and the "stop voltage" should be set to "auto."







MAKE THE MOST OUT OF YOUR SMARTWHEEL CONTROLS



Mastering your SmartWheel Controls will make the difference in optimizing your Entegra Coach's smooth ride. These easily accessible buttons control everything from your wipers to your high beams, so knowing just the right buttons to push is essential. Here are some tips:

1

Press the "ON" button and then "SET" when you first turn on your ignition to make sure your engine is running at a high idle. (This is necessary to fully inflate the air system before you drive. To cancel, press "ON/OFF" again.)

TIP

Signal to other drivers by activating your headlights and marker lights. They are turned on and off with a click.

Activate your cruise control by pressing "SET" and "RES."

Control your own wiper speed by activating the far-right wiper button on the right-hand side. Press it again to set your own time increment.

5

Change volume and music without taking your eyes off the road. These controls are located on the sides of your SmartWheel.

FROM FAST CARS TO
RV GADGETS, ENTEGRA'S
BRUCE OLMSTED WON'T
RETIRE HIS INGENUITY

When Bruce Olmsted hung up his hat as a mechanical engineer, he forgot to leave something behind — his lifelong hankering for gadgets.


Now, seven years into retirement, after a 30-year career working for a privately-held engineering corporation, Olmsted is fondly known as the Gadget Guy.

With that title comes a sort of ingenuity that the 66-year-old Entegra Coach owner just can't seem to retire.

If Olmsted isn't tuning up his 1938 Ford Coupe, adding computerized electronics to his beloved 1961 Corvette or racing his GT Lite in a Sports Car Club of America race, then he's off devising a plan to sell something innovative.

Recently, Olmsted joined up with two other RVers to produce, market and sell a self defense product designed specially for the RV industry.

Under the umbrella name of RV Defense, Olmsted hopes to put these tools into the hands of fellow full-timers for added safety against

unwanted intruders, wild animals and overzealous dogs. These pepper spray products that give RVers the tools (and the time) they need to "get away from a bad situation."

"Pepper spray gives the RV community a simple, easy-to-use weapon that is legal throughout the United States," Olmsted says. There are a few state restrictions to consider, though, like product weight, spray potency and canister appearance.

And while Olmsted is overseeing the marketing efforts of RV Defense, one of his partners is touring the country, instructing law enforcement officers and public department employees on how to use similar self defense sprays.

Along with RV Defense, Olmsted has begun pitching another coach necessity — the RV Wonder Cloth, a streak-free microfiber cloth that cleans windows, mirrors and stainless steel. With all this wheeling and dealing going on, it might also be safe to say Olmsted also forgot to hang up his salesman hat.

"He's a busy guy, and I'm just along for the ride," laughs Olmsted's wife, Beverly. Considering Olmsted usually notches 3.7 miles in just 2 minutes, 45 seconds, it can be a very fast-paced retirement indeed.

Back at homebase, in Englewood, Fla., Olmsted slows down just a little. You can find him in his 30'-by-48' garage where he's usually adding bells and whistles to something, even on his Entegra Coach.

"I'm the first guy to put automatic basement door locks on an Aspire," Olmsted beams. He also installed a ceiling fan, and Beverly introduced mood lighting inside their coach.

Simply put, Beverly says, "when it comes to mechanical things, Bruce never ceases to amaze."

A LITTLE WINTER CRUNCH

TUSCAN BREAD SALAD WITH GRILLED RADDICHIO & ENDIVE

Winter is normally a season filled with hearty, simmering stews.

But every now and then, we find ourselves craving the light crunch of a fresh salad.

So there's nothing like a grilled winter salad to remind us of summer.

We sunk our teeth into this recipe during the 2014 Entegra Coach Summerfest. There, in Petoskey, Mich., Entegra Coach owners were treated to a Galley Gourmet wine and grilling class. When we pulled out this Tuscan Bread Salad recipe, we were thrilled to discover its winter timeliness. Packed with some of the best winter produce — winter's perfectly peaked raddichio, the peppery bite of arugula and the subtle bitterness of endive — this grilled salad made us think of summer all over again.

TUSCAN BREAD SALAD WITH GRILLED RADDICHIO & ENDIVE SERVES 8, DEPENDING ON APPETITE

SHOPPING LIST

For the Bread

- 8 slices rustic Italian bread
- 1/2 cup olive oil
- 2 teaspoons garlic, crushed

For the Vinaigrette

- 1 teaspoon garlic, minced
- 3 flat anchovies, minced
- 1 tbsp. capers, rough chopped
- 1/4 cup red wine vinegar
- 1/2 cup extra virgin olive oil

For the Salad

- 1/2 cup extra virgin olive oil
- 1 tbsp. garlic, minced
- 2 Belgium endive
- 2 radicchio
- 3 Roma tomatoes, sliced
- 4 cups arugula
- 1 cup fresh basil leaves, rough chopped
- 1 zucchini
- Salt and pepper, to taste
- Aged pecorino or good-quality parmesan cheese, grated or shaved

- For the Bread
 - Mix the olive oil and garlic together in a bowl. Brush the bread slices with the olive oil and grill or broil until toasted. Cut the bread slices into thirds.
- For the Vinaigrette Mix all the ingredients together.
- For the Salad Split the Belgium endive in half and the raddichio in quarters, maintaining the root ends.
- Split the zucchini into fourths lengthwise and remove the seedy center.
- Mix together the olive oil and garlic for the salad. Brush the endive, raddichio and zucchini with the olive oil-garlic mixture and season with salt and pepper. Grill lightly on a medium grill until marked.
- Remove the tough cores from the endive and raddichio and cut into 6 bite-size pieces. Cut the zucchini into chunks.
- Combine the rest of the ingredients for the salad in a bowl with the grilled bread.
- Sprinkle the Vinaigrette over the salad and garnish with shaved aged pecorino or grated parmesan. Season with salt and freshly ground pepper. Then, enjoy!

PARADISE FOUND

Your soul sighs as your toes sink into the white sand. Tiki bars dot the ocean-filled horizon and the smell of Caribbean barbecue accompanies the gentle breeze. The laid-back rhythm reshuffles your to-do list, and you wonder why you didn't come yesterday. Welcome to the Florida Keys, a paradise found in your Entegra Coach.



Pull in your rig and unroll your welcome mat to the most southernmost point in the United States, and while it has a Florida zip codes, you'll find the Keys is an experience that stands apart from the rest of this state. "There is a joke among people here about the Keys being a different country," said Rita Clark, an RV lot owner at Bluewater Key RV Resort. It certainly feels like it.

Once you cross over U.S. 1 — the Overseas Highway — you trade the urban chaos of Florida cities with the less-traveled, unhurried pace of the Keys' seaside villages, complete with thatched tiki huts. "This place is what windows are made for," Clark said. And boats and fishing poles too.

Barracuda, sailfish, wahoo, snapper and grouper can be fished in the turquoise waters with required permits. Sunset cruises, glass bottom boat tours and water skiing are easily accessible. The climate also is more bearable than the rest of Florida, being 8-10 degrees cooler in the summer and a few degrees warmer in the winter.

"The island lifestyle is very real here," Clark said. "Everything is so relaxed and you are really living outdoors — whether you're barbecuing or on the water or just enjoying the views. It's a very different life."

A RESORT WITH THE SOUTHERN-MOST HOSPITALITY

For RVers who want to tap into the Keys' lifestyle, they can pull their rig into the Boyd's Key West Campground at the bottom of the Keys. Recently named by Travel Channel as "One of the Top 10 Places to See by RV," the campground is located right on the Atlantic Ocean with 200 lots and the ability to accommodate any size RV and their slideouts.

"It is beautiful here. We have so many pretty views," said Andie Baker, a sales associate at Boyd's Key West Campground. "People will love the weather and being open to the water."

Add in 24-hour security, wireless Internet and boat ramps and docks and it's no wonder that Boyd's often is booked far in advance. The campground offers a fresh water pool, a large sun deck, and of course, a shaded tiki hut area with entertainment and the weekly-crowd favorite live bluegrass music. There also is a shaded pavilion for reunions, rallies or just a potluck with your new group of friends.

"When people come, they stay for a few months, make friends and then they all come back again together, Baker said. "It's a great place."

There are craft classes, yoga and fashion shows, and if you need help with your on-site parking and hookup connections or tips or arranging off-site tours, someone will give you a hand. "Our campground motto is "Southern Most Hospitality," Baker said. "Our staff gets so many compliments. We're here to help out."

It was one that beckoned several U.S. Presidents — Harry Truman, Franklin D. Roosevelt, Dwight D. Eisenhower, John Kennedy and Jimmy Carter — to steal away to enjoy the islands' relaxed ways.

Nobel winner Ernest Hemingway also found a home here. While on the ferry from Cuba, he discovered his car was delayed and opted to stay in Key West for a few days. Ten years later, he finally left after writing portions of "A Farewell to Arms."

Playwrights also fell in love with the Keys' paradise. Tennessee Williams spent three decades in Key West, and his Academy Award-winning film adaptation of his play, "The Rose Tattoo," was shot on the islands.

Today, there are lively festivals that capture the islands' rich personality from Fantasy Fest in October — Key West's version of the Mardi Gras street party — to the annual Conch Shell Blowing Contest in March.
